2. Suriname has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) to partially finance the cost of the Labor Market Alignment With New Industries and intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the Contract detailed in this Request for Bids.

The Ministry Of Labor, Employment Opportunity, And Youth Affairs invites eligible bidders to submit sealed bids for The delivery of the non-consulting service "Integrator for the Design, Development, Implementation, Adoption and Operation of the National Labor Intermediation System (LIS) and Labor Market Information System (LMIS) of Suriname" consisting of the complete, single-cycle delivery of the full LIS/LMIS platform..

The Request for Bids (RFB) will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding process as specified in the [Inter-American Development Bank's Procurement Policies for the Procurement of Goods and Works](#) (applicable edition according to the Loan Contract) and is open to all bidders from eligible countries, as defined in the Bidding Documents.
